

Marketing support for Spot On promoters

After you decide to take a **Spot On** show, we will support you with marketing for your event. Here's what we'll do:

- 1) Upload the show and event details to the Spot On **website** and include them in the physical and digital copies of our season brochure.
- 2) Upload the show to the Visit Lancashire website.
- 3) Promote the show across **social media** platforms Twitter and Facebook. The frequency of this will increase as the date of the show approaches.
- 4) Request companies directly send you the printed publicity such as **flyers** and **posters**. You need to check with the artists if you are concerned about a delay in sending this print. (We will provide labels, brochures, tickets and paperwork including feedback forms)
- 5) Send out a **press release** to local and regional press (print, online and broadcast), approximately one month before the date of the event.

Here are a few tips for you as **promoters** to help boost your ticket sales too:

1) Where possible, **distribute** your posters and flyers far and wide. As a local you know all the best places to catch people's eyes so take advantage of them!

- 2) Add your Spot On event to your **village/venue website** we can provide digital copies of the show information you just need to ask.
- 3) Add or link your Spot On event to your own **Facebook** profile or if you administrate a group or page don't forget to promote here too.
- 4) Target suitable **local groups**, societies, schools etc. that you think may be interested in the show. You might want to email them or send a letter with a small batch of flyers.
- 5) **Word of mouth!** Don't be afraid to spread the word and plug the show to friends and family at every opportunity. This is still the most effective way of getting people to come along.
- 6) If you have **local press** contacts or know other organisations that you think we should be targeting please do let us know.
