How long can you play a flute using only one breath?

Kathryn Williams is a flautist, artist, and researcher. Her music focuses on making connections between the instrument and the body. 'Coming Up for Air' is a performance about creatively overcoming Kathryn's experience of a chronic respiratory condition; the project saw her commission over 100 pieces of music, all limited to a single breath.

Expect unique performances with the audience selecting the content and order of the pieces. Composers include Chaya Czernowin, Oliver Coates, Amber Priestley, Andy Ingamells, Larry Goves, Annie Hui-Hsin Hsieh, Newton Armstrong, Mary Bellamy, Stephen Chase, Sarah Hennies, Mauricio Pauly, and Brian Ferneyhough. The youngest composer represented is just eight years old!





Splat! is a physical comedy about art and creativity for ages 3-7.

FESTIVAL INFORMATION

Travel

If you're a local resident of Poulton we strongly encourage you to leave the car at home and walk or cycle into town if you can. Regular bus services can drop you off at the Market Place, the library and Booths.

By car

Poulton is accessible from the motorway network. It's just off the main A585 link road from the M55 to the coast.

Parking

In Poulton town centre, there is a mixture of free parking, pay-and-display car parks, and on-street car parking. The centre of Poulton is pedestrianised around the Market Square. Streets surrounding this area are largely one-way and regulated with double yellow lines.

Wyre Council operates a free car park at the Civic Centre (FY6 7PU).

On Hardhorn/Wheatsheaf Road (FY6 7TB) you'll find a long-stay pay-and-display car park. Parking time slots are up to 2 hours, 2 to 4 hours, 4 to 6 hours, and over 6 hours.

Please note: You can only park for free for up to three hours in the Teanlowe Shopping Centre car park in Poulton town centre - fines are in operation. There is a limited amount of free on-street parking on side streets throughout the town centre area and we advise you to be courteous to local residents and their access.

By train

Poulton-le-Fylde also has its own railway station, with good inland and coast links. Leaving the station entrance, head to your left, and within only 100 yards, you'll be in the main shopping area.

By taxi

There is a taxi rank outside the train station.

Toilets

Each festival venue has wheelchair-accessible toilets and baby changing facilities. Public toilets are located in the Teanlowe Centre Car Park.

Lost child area

For the festival's duration, we will operate a lost child area within the Teanlowe Centre in our festival hub (towards the Booths entrance).
