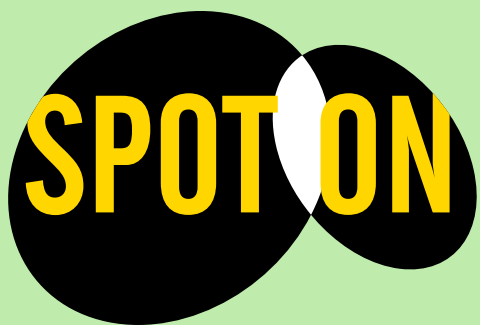
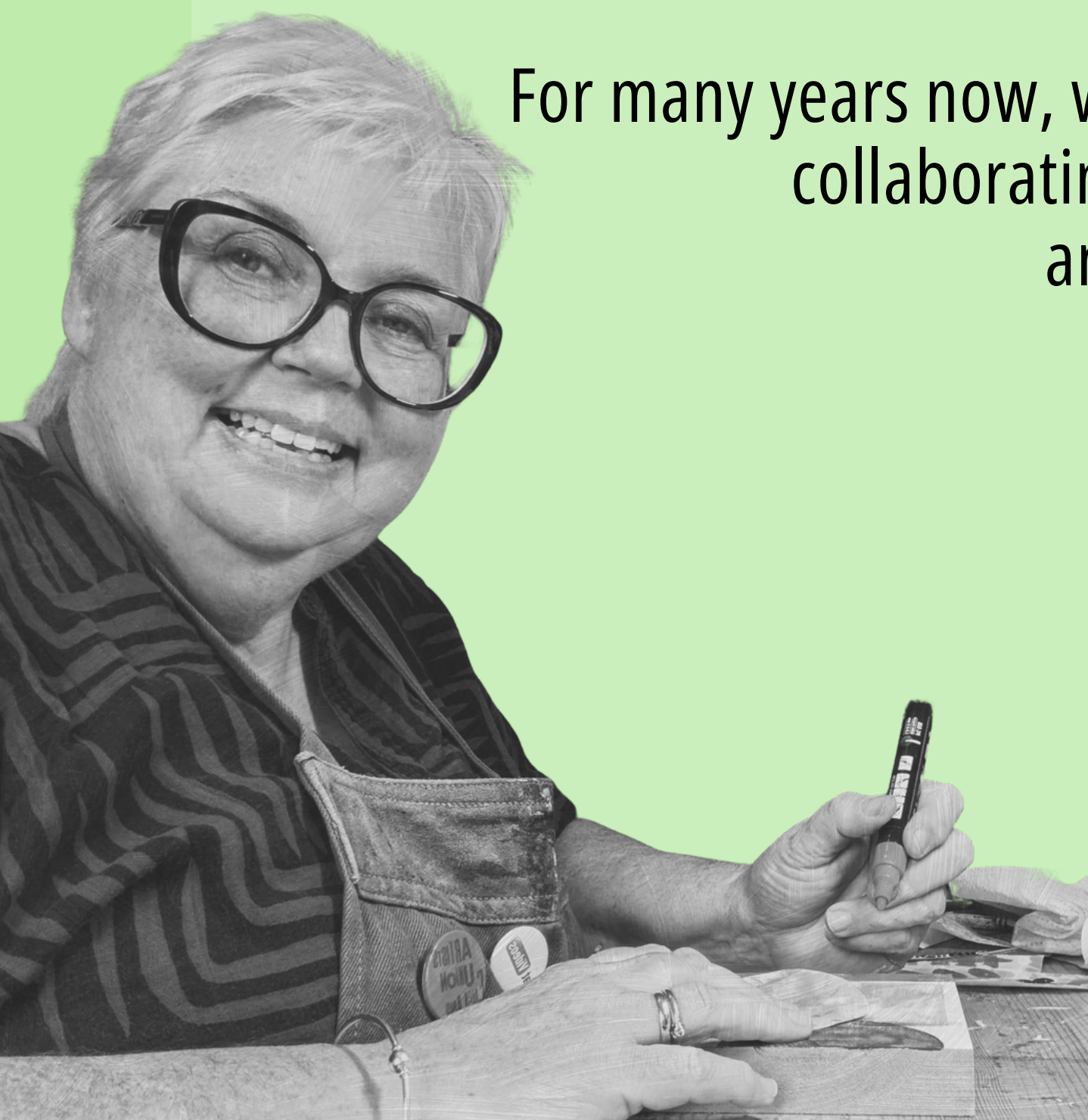




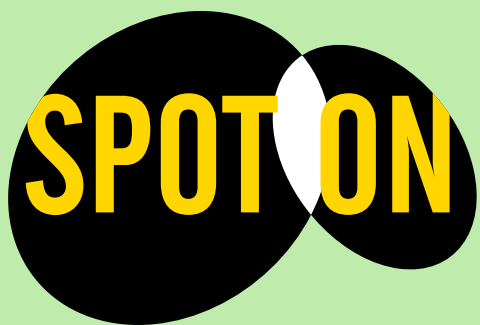

For many years now, we have been collaborating with artist and illustrator Cath Ford.



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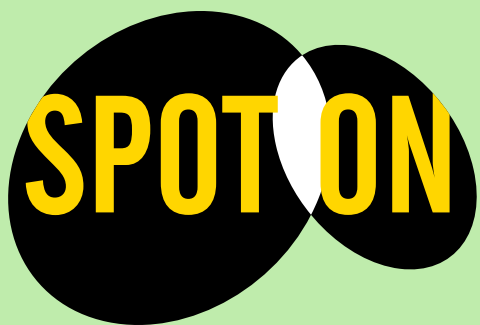

She designed our Spot On 30 newspaper front cover, but is also responsible for two other pieces of illustration work when we did our Spot On At Home newspapers during Covid.



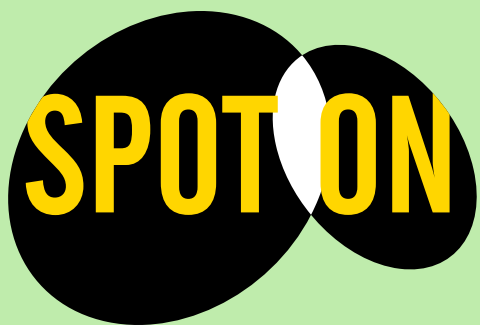

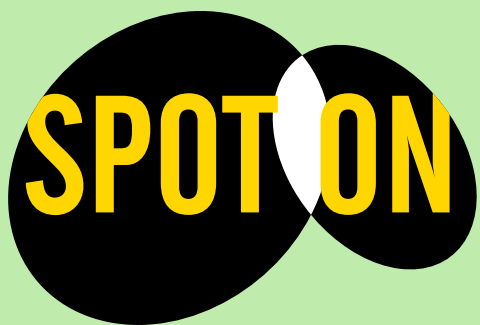
